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#### **OHCA and Tribal Leaders convene for Annual Tribal Consultation**

Representatives from the Oklahoma Health Care Authority (OHCA) met recently with tribal leaders from across the state for a roundtable discussion on tribal health topics.

The annual consultation provides an opportunity for Oklahoma tribes to receive updates, as well as give input and ask questions about SoonerCare (Oklahoma Medicaid) and Insure Oklahoma. The meeting also brings state tribal leaders together to brainstorm and share best practices with OHCA.

This year's consultation got underway with a breakfast sponsored by the Southern Plains Tribal Health Board (SPTHB); followed by opening remarks from SPTHB Executive Director Jennifer LittleSun, and Ed McFall, OHCA board chairman. After individual introductions of tribal leaders, OHCA Tribal Government Relations Director Dana Miller presented a report to the group.

## **Transforming Systems of Care for Children**

Although frustrated efforts to build collaborative systems go back to Biblical times (think Tower of Babel), the specific form of collaboration known as "system of care for children and adolescents with serious emotional disturbance" (SOC) goes back only about 35 years. It has been at the heart of child mental health policy in the United States ever since.

But recently, and especially since the passage of the Affordable Care Act (ACA), ambitious new goals for child mental health have emerged, emphasizing hopes to prevent emotional disturbance and to serve all children and adolescents with emotional struggles, not just those whose functioning is already quite limited.
