Medicare Changes coming January 2024

In 2024, key Medicare changes include a Part B premium increase to \$174.70, an increase from \$164.90 in 2023 and a \$32 rise in the Part A deductible to \$1,632. Notably, about 99% of beneficiaries won't pay a Part A premium. The annual Part B deductible is \$240, an increase from \$226 in 2023. Moreover, clinical social workers, MFTs, and counselors will receive 75% of psychologist rates, with pending enrollment rules. Ohio Behavioral Health Information System (OBHIS)

The Ohio Behavioral Health Information System (OBHIS) is the department's upgrade to the OHBH, a client-level episode of care information and outcomes reporting system.

System Features

- OBHIS application access through OH|ID accounts in the iPortal
- Client records verified against claims data (e.g., GOSH, SmartCare)
- Schema and other resources for batch uploading XML files
- Template and other resources for batch uploading Excel/XLSX files
- Business rules and user guides
- Standardized administrative reports
