How emotional health and physical health alarms differ

A certain number of people in any given population reach a point where their health status deteriorates to meeting criteria for either pre-disease or disease state for a clinical condition. People may be moving into full blown diabetes, congestive health failure, or major depression, for example. However, the path to being acutely ill is not the same for each condition. Some have alarm bells sooner than others, and some have a greater subjective sense of illness and impaired functioning along the path to fully qualifying for a diagnosis.

Opioids can cause harm in hospitals beyond addiction risk

Errors in opioid prescriptions and use during patients' hospital stays may be the cause of more harm than previously thought, according to a new analysis.

The study, released Tuesday by patient safety research organization ECRI Institute, found approximately 35% of adverse events involving opioids stemmed from errors in administering the highly addictive drugs during a hospital stay.


Mental Health, Substance Abuse Services In Oklahoma Face Budget Cuts

The Oklahoma Department of Mental Health and Substance Abuse Services will outline the programs being eliminated due to budget cuts in the state's behavioral health care system during a news conference Wednesday.

With more than 950,000 Oklahomans struggling with mental illness the cuts will impact 1 in 4 residents. The agency's commissioner, Terri White, is calling these cuts unbearable.

If additional funds are not allocated for the 2018 fiscal year, the Oklahoma Department of Mental Health and Substance Abuse Services will be forced to initiate a \$75 million cut. To put it into perspective, that accounts for more than 20% of the agencies overall budget.

Lawmakers Pass Measures To Try To Fill Budget Hole

State lawmakers have begun to fill the state's \$215 million budget hole, but it's coming without a compromise.

The House passed several measures, allowing them to pull \$106 million from carryover funds from last year's and Rainy Day funds. It's meant to help stop the bleeding from the state's core health agencies.
