

MAPS 4 advisers recommend preliminary plans for new Mental Health Crisis Center in NE OKC

Advisers are recommending plans for a new mental health crisis center in northeast Oklahoma City as part of the \$1.1 billion MAPS 4 program. Voters approved nearly \$45 million for mental health facilities in 2019. The center will merge two existing programs into one, offering crisis response, detox, counseling, and stabilization. Set for 1200 NE 13, the 27,830-square-foot facility will feature designs to reduce institutional feelings. Budget concerns include a proposed warming kitchen instead of a full kitchen and fewer beds than originally planned. Construction is expected to finish by mid-2027, pending approval and budget adjustments.

Millions of dollars from opioid settlement funds are being distributed to organizations in northwest Ohio to support addiction recovery and prevention efforts. OneOhio Recovery Foundation is overseeing \$4.1 million in grants, including funding for Lucas County Children Services, the Zepf Center, and Harbor. These funds will help expand services, including support for families in recovery and peer support programs, with a focus on the LGBTQ+ community. This is just the first round of funding, and more will come as additional settlement payments are made. While progress has been made, officials emphasize that the fight against the opioid crisis is far from over.
