Oklahoma Department of Mental Health and Substance Abuse Services (ODMHSAS) is proposing a rate increase for service. Scroll down below to know more information.

DMH has updated the Pregnancy Values for the CDC that starting on **July 1st 2022**. All CDCs must let users select from the following values for Pregnancy. Previously, the values for "Are you pregnant" ? are just Yes or No; but now :

- 1.Not Pregnant
- 2. Pregnant with Family Care Plan
- 3. Pregnant without Family Care Plan but interested
- 4. Pregnant without Family Care Plan with no interest
- 5. plan to have child in the next year with Family Care Plan
- 6. plan to have a child in next year without Family Care plan but interested
- 7. plan to have a child in next year without Family Care Plan with no interest

OK SPA 22-0032 Rate Increases for Outpatient Behavioral Health Agency Services, Residential Level of Care Substance Use Disorder Services, and Independently Contracted Psychologists

The ODMHSAS proposes to increase rates for select services that are currently reimbursed less through SoonerCare than through ODMHSAS state funds or that have not seen increases in recent years. Services receiving rate increases include: individual and family therapy, individual Assertive Community Treatment, individual and group community recovery support, group psychosocial rehabilitation/illness management and recovery, and screening and referral. Proposed rate increases range from 7.5% to 100% and a new rate for complex screening and referral is being proposed. The new proposed rate for complex screening and referral is \$75.00 per event. Additionally, the ODMHSAS proposes to increase rates for residential level of care substance use disorder services.

DeWine Signs Ohio Capital Budget

Gov. Mike DeWine, has signed the \$3.5 billion capital budget into law. Like previous capital budgets, this one includes money for improvements to public facilities and waterways but this one is different in one significant way. DeWine said the state normally issues bonds to cover many of the improvements identified in previous capital budgets — but not this time. "What's unusual about this budget is, out of the \$2.8 billion that can be bonded, we intend to pay for part, or possibly all of it, with cash. The capital budget includes money for mental and behavioral health treatment facilities, state parks, shoring up Ohio's waterways and more. The measure provides more than \$92 million for mental health and addiction services across the state. It includes support for renovations and improvements at state hospitals, and funding for recovery housing, mental health treatment facilities, and community program spaces. The funding will also support community resiliency projects for middle and high school youth. The projects that will benefit from this funding focus on treatment and recovery, risk reduction, improved quality of care, and enhancing partnerships in communities.
