# Columbus pledges funds to mental health, addiction, affordable housing

Columbus City Council approved funding for addiction prevention, youth mental health, and affordable housing. Grants will support the Rapid Response Emergency and Addiction Crisis Team (RREACT) in helping those with substance use disorders and their families, continuing a decline in Franklin County overdose deaths. Nearly \$87,000 will fund a youth suicide prevention program, and \$1.2 million will restore two Hilltop buildings, adding 10 housing units and commercial space as part of the Zone-In neighborhood revitalization plan.
