Provider Incentive Directed Payment Program

This program aims to support health care quality and access improvement initiatives.

Eligible Providers:

- Advanced practice nurses, mid-level practitioners, mental health providers, licensed behavioral health practitioners, podiatrists, physicians, anesthesiologist assistants.

Program Highlights:

- \$25 increase for SBIRT screenings, after-hours care, and well visit services.
- 19% increase on payments for non-HIE entities, 28% for HIE-connected entities.
- Only paid claims by MCEs between 4/1 and 6/30 are eligible.

Maximize your payments by ensuring claims are adjudicated by June 30.

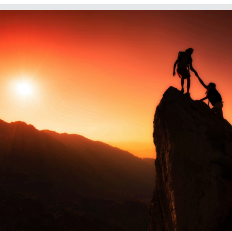

This event will provide sector-focused learning opportunities for first responders, educators, mental health providers, healthcare providers, and the general public.

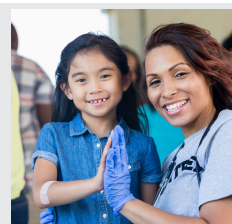

Oklahoma Mental Health Policy Highlights of the 2024 Legislative Session

The 2024 legislative session brought significant advancements to Oklahoma's mental health infrastructure. Building on previous investments, lawmakers focused on addressing the critical need for mental health professionals to staff new and expanded facilities. Key achievements include:

- **\$5 Million Appropriation:** This funding supports a 30% increase in psychiatric residency positions.
 - **Legislation for Social Workers:** New bills align licensure requirements with other states, speeding up the process for social workers to enter the workforce.
 - **Data Collection Improvement:** Streamlined data collection will provide clearer insights into the behavioral health workforce.
 - **Increased Funding for ODMHSAS:** A 7.8% budget increase supports various mental health initiatives.

Dayton Expected to Land New, State-Run Behavioral Health Hospital

Ohio Gov. Mike DeWine has confirmed plans for a new state-run behavioral health hospital in Dayton, following the state's capital budget discussions. The \$10 million appropriation in the \$3.5 billion budget will fund land acquisition and initial designs for the facility, which will be Ohio's seventh state-run behavioral health hospital.

Key points include:

- **200-Bed Facility:** The hospital will provide inpatient care, easing the burden on private hospitals.
- **Funding and Timeline:** \$10 million allocated for land and designs, with additional costs and timelines yet to be determined.
- **Previous Closure:** Dayton's previous state-run psychiatric hospital, Twin Valley, closed 16 years ago, significantly impacting local mental health services.
- **Community Impact:** The new facility is expected to benefit the criminal justice system and fill a critical gap in the region's behavioral health ecosystem.
